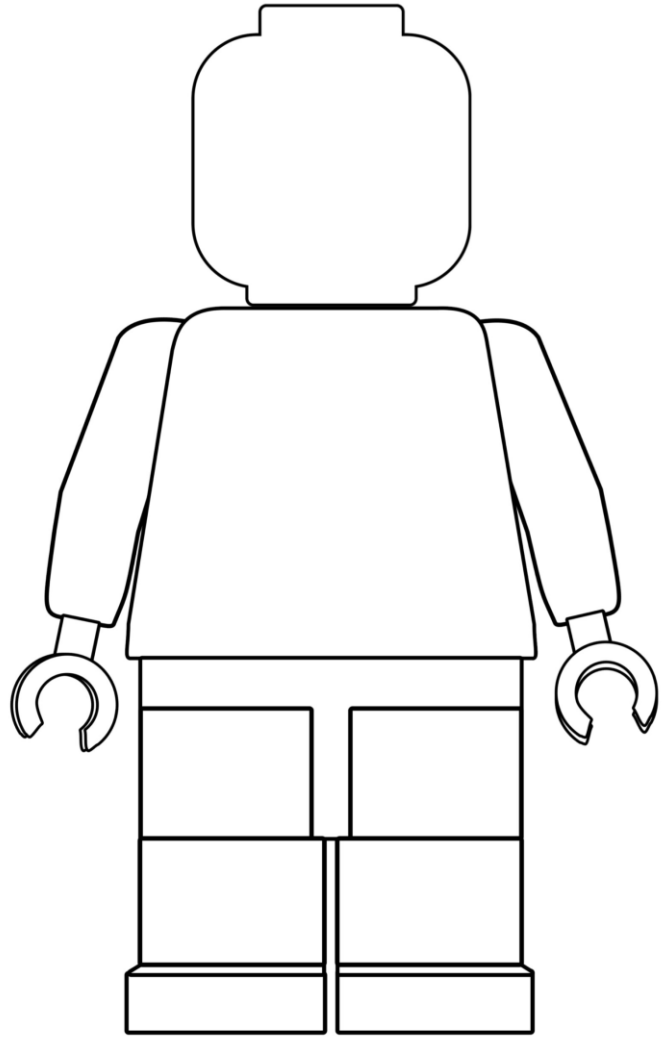
# Equipment

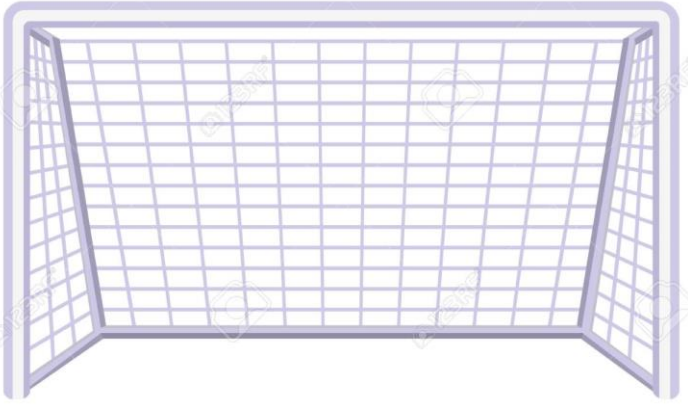

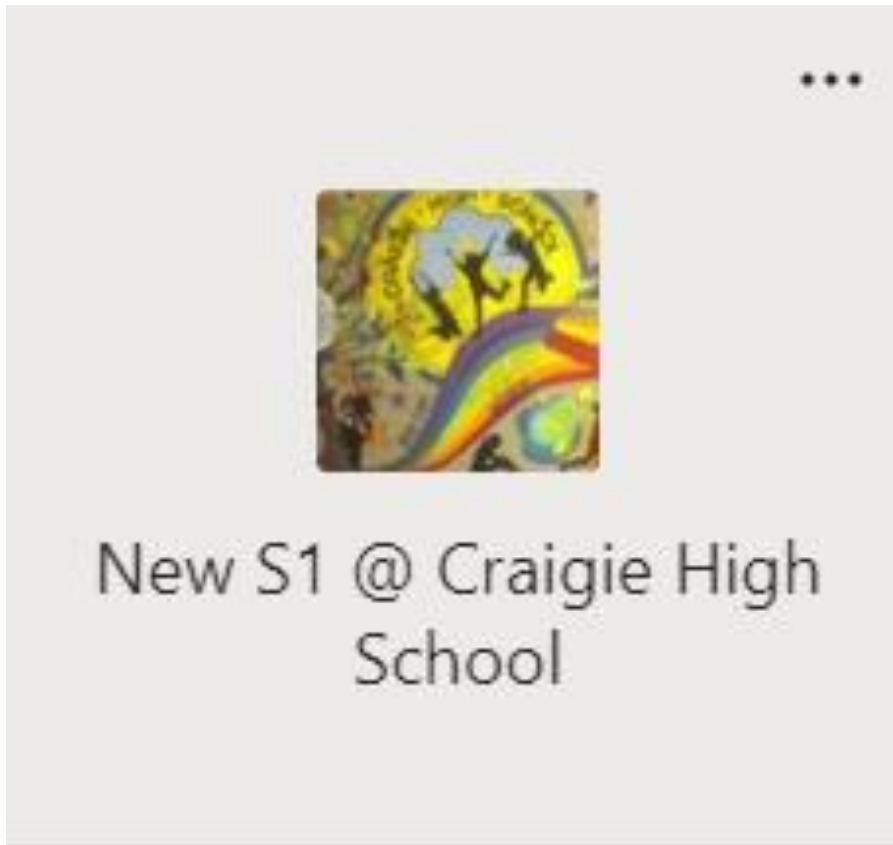
