
Michelle and Colin, our Pupil Support Workers work in this room. Remember we are here to help!

I am passionate about supporting young people to achieve their potential and enjoy outdoor learning. You can become involved with a range of opportunities for pupils to gain awards.

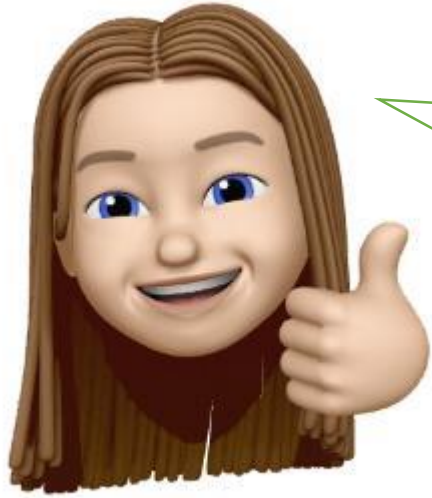

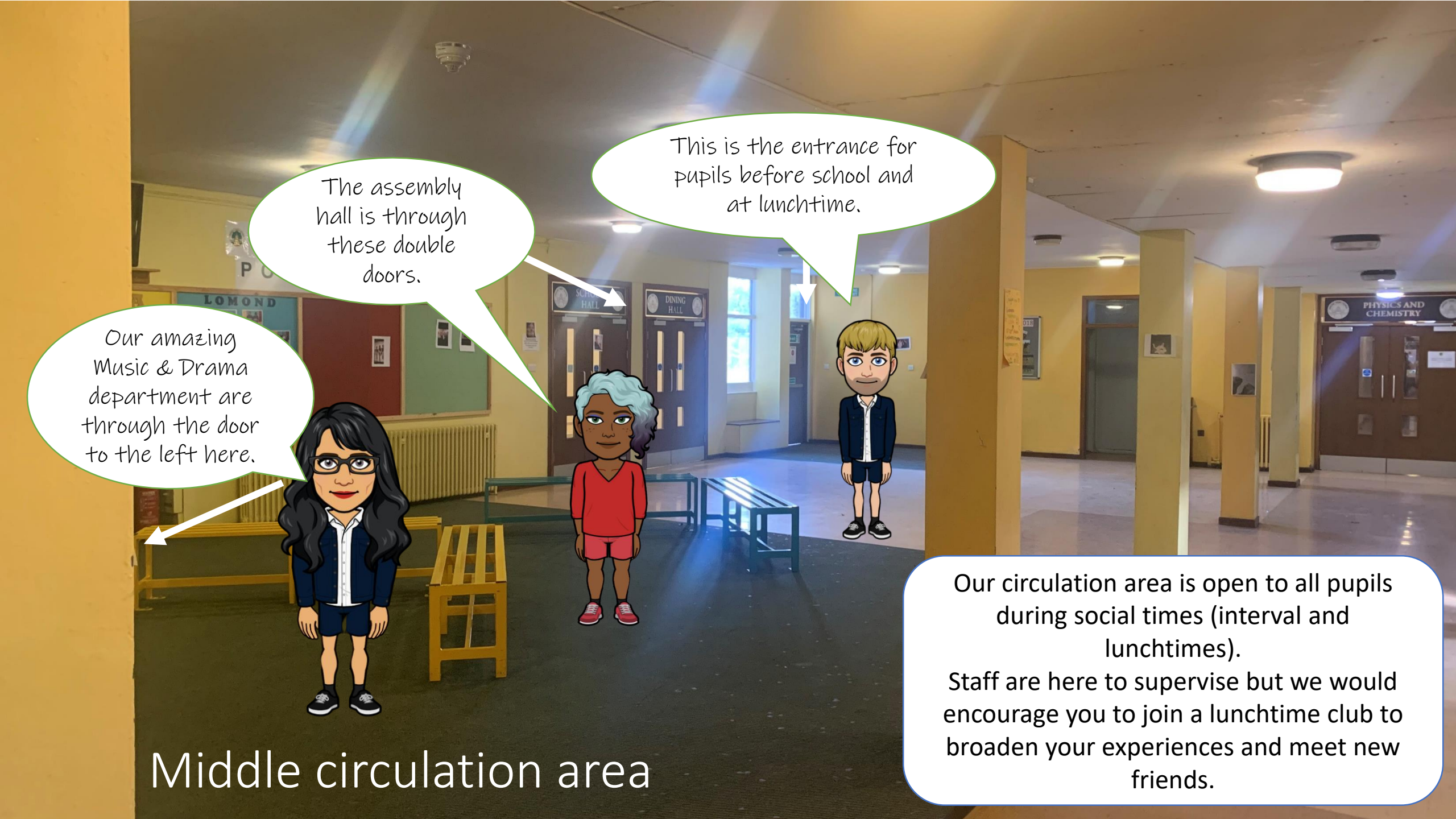
Our amazing Music & Drama department are through the door to the left here.




This is where assemblies will be held, and you will find out information about the school and the opportunities that are on offer. This is also where we hold our concerts and performances!
