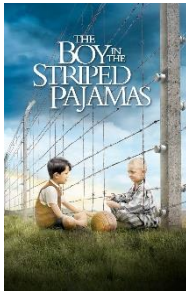

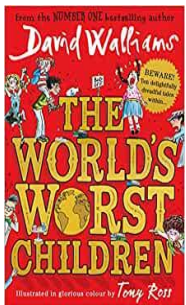


[The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas by John Boyne](#)

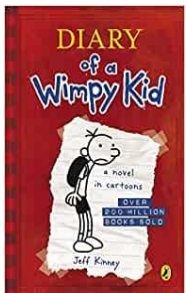


[The World's Worst Children by David Walliams](#)

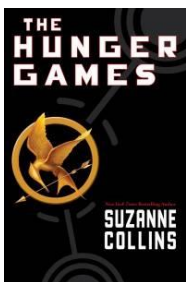


[Diary of a Wimpy Kid by Jeff Kinney](#)
