Show Racism the Red Card (SRtRC) is the leading UK anti-racism education charity. We produce **resources** and deliver **workshops** to equip Scotland's young people with the tools to tackle racism and discrimination.

SRtRC's Creative Competition is **free** to enter for all Scottish schools, is open to young people of all ages (P1 to S6) and is a great, positive way to engage young people's interest in anti-racism.

We accept submissions in any medium – **artwork, creative writing, poetry, music, film, posters, t-shirt designs, shoe/football boots design, anything!**

The competition categories support the main aims and capabilities of the Curriculum for Excellence.

Entries can be from **individual** learners, or as part of **groups**.

Schools have until **1st April 2022** to take part in the Creative Competition.

RULES

All entries should be original and can include curriculum work. Entrants must be resident in Scotland and be attending any Scottish school or FE college.

Entries must be submitted to competition@theredcardscotland.org either by email or WeTransfer.

Entries must be accompanied with completed entry forms (see back page).

Note: if your primary class is a composite (eg. P5/6) please indicate which age group the majority of your class represents.

Judging will take place during April 2022 by a panel of subject experts and surprise guests.

Finalists will be notified at the end of May with the overall category winners being announced at the awards ceremony, planned for Hampden Park, Glasgow later in the term.

All entrants to the competition will receive a certificate from Show Racism the Red Card.
