Can be paid weekly or termly or full year

Positive Behaviour Positive Rewards

- Each pupil can be awarded a merit any period from any member of staff for good effort/behaviour etc.
- Those pupils who achieve a set amount of merits will have opportunities to take part in different reward activities – GOLD, SILVER and BRONZE levels
- Examples – visits to cinema , pizza lunch or movie in the hall with popcorn and juice.
