

Dear Parent/Carer

I wanted to provide you with an update on what the new restrictions are in Craigie High School in light of the Scottish Government's decision to move Dundee into Tier 3.

In addition to measures in place that I have shared with you previously the following extra protective measure will apply in school from **Monday 2nd November 2020**.

**All staff and Senior Phase Pupils (S4 to S6) should wear a face covering in corridors, social areas and classrooms. This means that the only place where masks can be removed is when eating in the Dining Centre.**

Whilst the current national guidance is specific for all staff and senior phase pupils, I firmly believe that it is our moral and social responsibility to actively support all actions that can help reduce the impact of COVID in our learning community.

Therefore, I am asking you to support us in asking all pupils in the Broad General Education (S1 to S3) to adopt the updated rule of wearing a face covering at all times when in school as well.

It is important to note that these measures are in addition to, not instead of, the protective measures currently operating in the school. This includes, regular hand sanitising, the wearing of face coverings in the corridors and social areas, the cleaning of desks and equipment after use, and enhanced cleaning throughout the day across the school.

Our priority remains to support our pupils and to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our pupils and staff.
